



LATE-NIGHT TRAIL

Enjoy a late night stroll through Central London and discover the events of Art Night after dark.

8 – 8.45pm Duke of York Steps by the ICA

Start the night on The Mall by witnessing Linder's latest performance, a live theatrical tableau drawing influence from architects Alison and Peter Smithson's House of the Future, and Jacques Demy's iconic 1970s film *Donkey Skin*.

9 – 9.40pm Covent Garden Piazza

From the Mall you can easily walk to Covent Garden, simply cross Trafalgar Square, head along The Strand and turn left up Southampton Street.

In the East Piazza you can find a video installation by dance artist Cecilia Bengolea. Projected onto the Market's mirrored facade Bengolea's work marries Jamaican dancehall with classical ballet.

Inside the Apple Market you can take part in Jennifer West's latest film project. By writing and drawing your memories onto reels of 70mm film you will contribute to a communal artwork.

10 – 11.30pm Somerset House

Next, head along The Strand to Somerset House. Here you can check out the final performance of Xu Zhen's *Physique of Consciousness* produced by Madeln Company, a mass performance bringing one-hundred participants together to act in unison. If you are wearing comfortable clothing you can even take part by registering as a performer in the East Wing.

Afterwards enjoy a drink on the River Terrace.

11.30 – 12.00pm St Mary le Strand

Discover the baroque splendor of St Mary le Strand, a church located on the traffic island opposite King's College London. It features a screening of a new work by Jennifer West *Film Title Poem*. Lasting 15 minutes the montage of hand-painted 16mm film presents a personal history of the artist's relationship with cinema.

12.20 – 12.40am 180 Strand

Head East along the Strand to no.180, an iconic brutalist building overlooking the Thames. Inside you will find Celia Hempton's theatrical installation of abstracted bodies and landscapes.

12.40 – 1am 190 Strand

Next door at no.190 Nina Beier intervenes in a luxury show-flat with *Anti-ageing*, a living still-life performance.
